

**SHARON TOWNSHIP SPECIAL BOARD MEETING
June 28, 2010**

The Sharon Township Board held a special Board meeting on Monday, June 28, 2010. Jones called the meeting to order at 7:03 P.M. Board members present: Aiuto, Jones, Lavender and Yordanich. Absent: Chizmar. There were eighty-four plus (84) guests present.

The purpose of the special meeting was to discuss the millage proposal on the August 3, 2010 ballot that affects every property owner in Sharon Township.

Fred Lucas, the Township attorney briefed the residents on the events that lead to the judgment against Sharon Township and in favor of the Gourley Family, LLC for the sum of \$683,333.00. Lucas also reviewed over the Michigan statute 600.6093 which is the recovery of judgment against township, village, city, or county.

There were many public comments and questions. The two main questions were: "can the residents have the option of paying the one time assessment or having it amortized out to 15 years? Will it only be on the winter tax bill?" Lucas stated that he would have an answer to both of these questions at the 7/1/10 meeting.

Julie Helquist asked that a six month synopsis accompany the tax bills to keep the residents informed.

The Board reviewed the 2009-2010 Sharon Township budget. The following line items were over budget.
