

SHARON TOWNSHIP BOARD
SPECIAL MEETING (unapproved)
May 18, 2010

The Sharon Township Board held a special meeting on Tuesday, May 18, 2010. Jones called the meeting to order at 12:05 P.M. The following Board members were present: Aiuto, Chizmar, Jones, Lavender and Yordanich. There were no guests present.

The purpose of the meeting: to make a resolution to submit judgment funding bond proposal to the Washtenaw County Clerk by the deadline of May 25, 2010 for the August 2010 election.

Jones stated that Township attorney Fred Lucas nor his partner Scott Baker were available to be at the meeting and that the Board needed their guidance to make a decision.

After the Board reviewed the resolution to submit judgment funding bond proposal and its' exhibits, the Board had many questions. The main one being that the bond proposal wording would be too confusing to the voters and that if they voted the proposal down, that they would be charged a one time, one lump fee of 10+ mills instead of it 1+mill being amortized out for a 10 year period. The Board believed that the voters would not realize the repercussion of a "no" vote and felt that the wording needed to be changed to give the voters the opportunity to choose between the two choices.

Jones called Lucas office and left a message to call the Board back. The meeting was suspended at 12:30 P.M. upon waiting for Lucas' office to call back. Due to no call received from Lucas' office, the meeting was rescheduled for May 21, 2010 at 11:00 A.M.

Being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 12:55 P.M.
